Cook Dinner: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Find a recipe for your favorite main course. Add up the cost of the ingredients needed to make the meal (prices might be available on Amazon or a local grocery store site like Shaws or Stop and Shop) Find out the cost of the same meal at a restaurant. 	15	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Write out the name of the recipe and the cost at a restaurant and the cost of cooking it at home. Submit as a word document or take a picture of your handwritten notes An extra 5 points for sharing the recipe with us!
Sweet 16: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Time to buy a car! Research used cars in your area and find one that you want. Write down the price, year, make, and model. Will you try negotiate the price? What will your strategy be? How will you pay for the car? 	10	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Submit as a word document or take a picture of your handwritten notes. Earn extra 5 points if you tell us what your dream car is or upload a picture.
Lecture: Record yourself giving your pet, younger sibling, or your favorite stuffed animal a 3 minute presentation on something that you have learned in the Dollar \$cholar program so far.	10	Submit video.
Flashing the Plastic: Using your art skills, design a credit card. Beads, glitter, glue, or even candy are encouraged!	5	Submit a photograph of the credit card.
Future Mogul: Pretend you are the boss at your dream company and a young woman is coming to interview with your company. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> What is the business? What are 3 qualities you want your future employee to have and why? 	10	Submit as a word document or record a video of yourself answering these questions.
Song and Dance: Write a 30 second song, poem, or rap about saving money and making financially responsible choices. Record yourself performing it.	10	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Submit the video. Earn an extra 5 points if you do it in costume or have props.
Free Money: Research scholarships available to girls in your area. Find one that you would consider applying for or that fits your interests or goals.	10	Submit the link to the scholarship page

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<p>Words of Wisdom: Call or ask an adult in your life to give you one piece of financial advice that they wish they had known when they were age. Write down the advice and decorate it!</p>	15	Submit a photograph of your work.
<p>Emergency Funds: Write down 3 situations on why you would need savings/an emergency fund and how you would use your earnings to create a savings account.</p>	15	Submit a word document.
<p>My First Bank Account: Go online and find a bank that you'd want to start your first bank account with and how that process works. Send a picture of what bank you chose.</p>	15	Submit a photograph.
<p>Around the House: Put a timer of 2 minutes and try and find all the loose change in the house, add them up and email your total.</p>	5	Submit a photograph and the total of how much you found.
<p>Your Own Dollar Bill: Get creative and draw/make your own dollar bill-make sure to add a picture, how much the bill is and submit a picture of it!</p>	10	Submit a photograph.
<p>A Place of My Own:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Time to buy a house or apartment! Research homes and apartments in your area and find one that you want. 2. Write down the price and description of the place (how many bedrooms, bathrooms, etc). 3. Make sure to include utility bills like electricity, heat, TV, internet, etc. Be sure to research what companies you'll use and how much those cost and factor that into your living costs. 4. How will you pay for the place? 	15	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Submit as a word document or take a picture of your handwritten notes. 2. Earn extra 5 points if you tell us what your dream home is or upload a picture.
<p>Dream Job: Share your dream job, research their salaries. Share how much you think a monthly and weekly take home check would be. Remember to think about taxes!</p>	10	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Submit as a word document or take a picture of your handwritten notes. 2. Earn extra 5 points if you can also add health insurance costs and include that in your take home earnings. 3. Earn another 5 points if you dress up in costume as your dream job!
<p>Ultimate Budget Planning: Map out your budget! Use the earnings of your dream job to map out a budget for your bills, groceries, savings, etc. Feel free to use the items from what you've already worked on!</p>	10	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Submit a word document of your budget breakdown. 2. Earn extra 5 points if you can find an app and share how that helps build you a budget!
